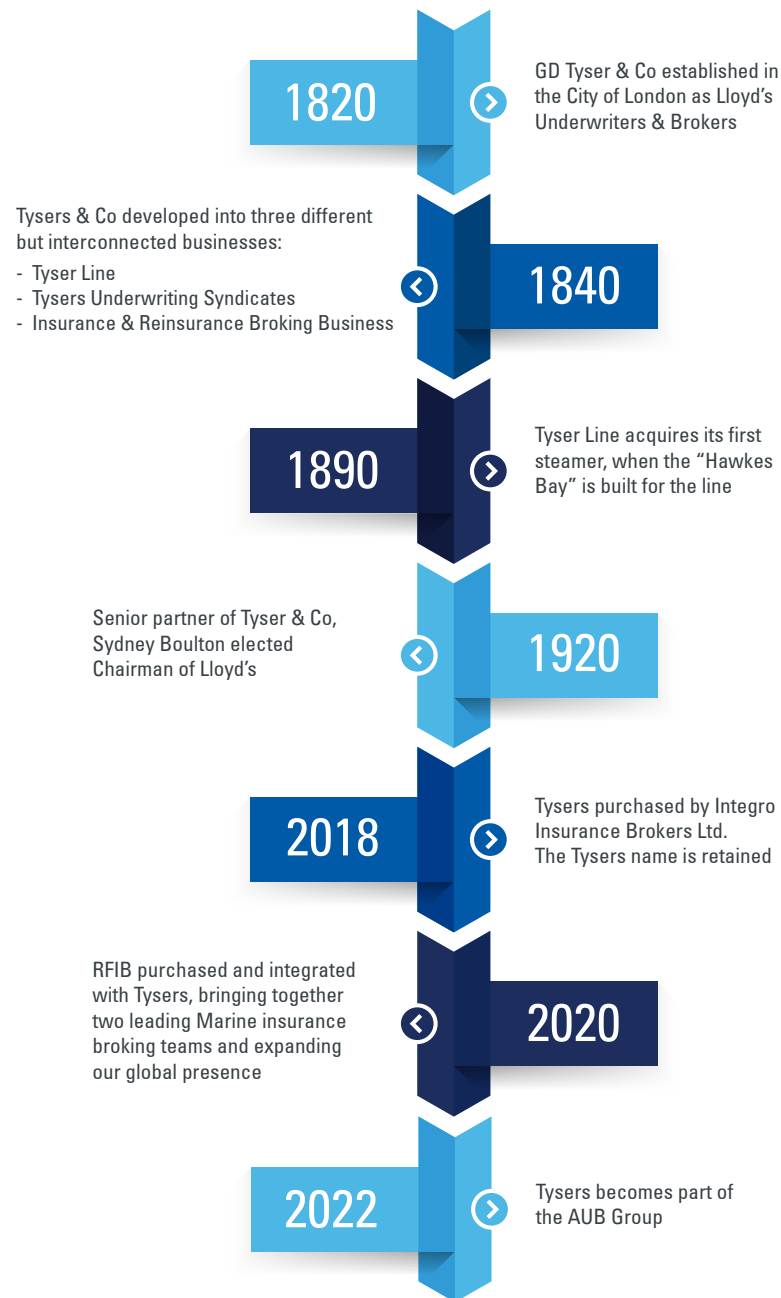
Tysers is a member of the AUB Group, an ASX200 listed company comprising insurance brokers and underwriting agencies placing c.US\$6.3bn+ GWP.
